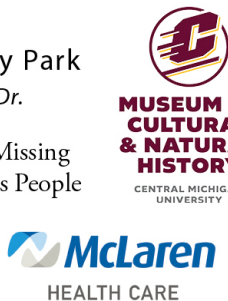
A Missing and Murdered Indigenous People Event
