Council is to help create happy, healthy homes for children to grow up in, by strengthening families through prevention, connections, and resiliency. She is a certified Children's Trust Alliance Trainer of "Bringing the Protective Factors Framework to life" Lisa has certification in Yellow Ribbon presentation, safeTALK (Suicide alertness for everyone) training, is an ASIST (Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training) trainer and a certified Instructor to train others as safeTALK Trainers. Her goal is to empower community members to help save lives through education. Along with being a wife, mother and grandmother, helping community members realize that they are worthy of asking for and receiving help, is Lisa's passion.
